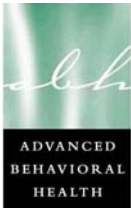

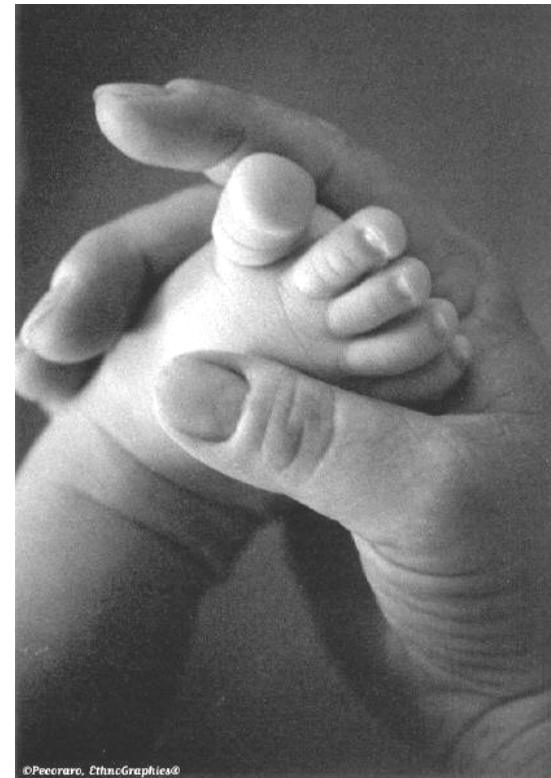

ECCCP MISSION

The Early Childhood Consultation Partnership strives to:

- **Provide mental health prevention and early intervention services**
- **Build capacity of parents, teachers, and caregivers**
- **Support and enhance relationship building**
- **Promote enduring and optimal mental health outcomes**



Program Management

- ECCP is managed by Advanced Behavioral Health (ABH), a private, nonprofit, behavioral health management company incorporated in 1995
- ABH Provides:
 - Statewide Program Management
 - Centralized data collection and reporting
 - Sub Contracts with 10 Non profit Behavioral Health Agencies
 - Training and supervision to 20 Early Childhood Mental Health Consultants



ECCP Goals

- Reduce Early Childhood Suspension and Expulsion
- Promote Healthy Social Emotional Development in Young Children through early childhood caregivers
- Prevention and Early Intervention
- Build Capacity of caregivers and at a systems level

Capacity Building: A Range of Services

- **Phone consultation:** Available to families and providers.
- **Collaboration:** ECCP promotes collaboration of a variety of early childhood systems through team meetings to review child specific plans.
- **Referrals:** To early childhood behavioral health providers to support the child and their family as needed.
- **Community Based Meetings:** Early Childhood Consultants sit on a variety of community groups and systems of care meetings.
- **TAB Trainings:** Are offered to Early Childhood Educators at their center that help them move toward their CDA.
- **Statewide training:** Offers statewide opportunities for families, early childhood educators, and early childhood providers to attend training and networking functions.
