#### **CONNECTICUT STATE CAPITOL POLICE DEPARTMENT NATIONAL ACCREDITATION ON-SITE ASSESSMENT**

The State Capitol Police Department is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of the process for again receiving National Accreditation.

National Accreditation was granted in March of 2003, by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), for this department. This on-site assessment verifies that the agency complies with the professional law enforcement standards established by CALEA.

The on-site assessment is administered by CALEA trained assessors. The assessors are assigned to verify that the agency complies with the standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the public are invited to offer comments at a public information session to be held on Monday, December 8, 2008 starting at 3:00 pm. The session will be conducted in hearing room 1C of the Legislative Office Building, located at 300 Capitol Avenue in Hartford.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling (860) 240-8455 on Tuesday, December 9, 2008, between the hours of 1:00 pm and 3:00 pm. Comments will be taken by the Assessment Team.

Telephone comments, as well as appearances at the public information session, are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with the Commission's standards. A viewing of the standards is available at the State Capitol Police Department administrative office located in room 1200 of the Legislative Office Building, 300 Capitol Avenue in Hartford.
