

How To Search for a Connecticut General Statute

1. Go to the Connecticut General Assembly website: www.cga.ct.gov.
2. Hover your mouse over "Search," then click on "Basic Legislative Document Search." This brings up a search page.
3. You'll notice the current year is set as a default in the search criteria. Delete this date and leave the field blank to search all years.
4. Be sure to select "Statutes (as of 1/1/05)" under the middle column, "Laws and Related Documents."
5. Enter the Connecticut General Statute you wish to search in the "Search For" field. You can find the Statute that coordinates with the board or commission you are interested in by referencing the document "Connecticut State Boards and Commissions."
6. Choose the correct CGS from your search results by clicking on the link under the "Document Name" column.

Once you've researched numerous boards and commissions, we encourage you to submit your resume and a letter of interest to the Governor's office. Our document "How to Get Appointed to State Boards and Commissions" will help you with this process.
