3 "(4) "Engage in the business" means that the person engages in the  
4 business for the purpose of compensation or profit;"

5 In line 36, strike "(2) any other person holding a professional" and  
6 insert in lieu thereof the following "(2) any person licensed or  
7 otherwise authorized under chapter 412 of the general statutes to sell  
8 or place a mobile manufactured home, as defined in section 21-64 of  
9 the general statutes, upon a mobile manufactured home park or mobile  
10 manufactured space or lot, both as defined in section 21-64 of the  
11 general statutes, provided such person engages only in work for which  
12 such person is licensed or otherwise authorized under chapter 412 of  
13 the general statutes; (3) any other person holding a professional"

26 "Sec. 5. Section 5 of public act 99-246 is repealed and the following is  
27 substituted in lieu thereof:

28 In addition to any other remedy provided for in [this act] public act  
29 99-246, as amended by this act, any person who violates any provision  
30 of subsection (d) of section 4 of [this act, except subdivision (7) of said  
31 subsection (d)] public act 99-246, as amended by this act, shall be guilty  
32 of a class A misdemeanor. Notwithstanding subsection (d) of section  
33 53a-29 or section 54-56e, if the court determines that a contractor  
34 cannot fully repay any victim of the violations committed by the  
35 contractor within the period of probation established in subsection (d)  
36 of section 53a-29 or section 54-56e, the court may impose probation for  
37 a period of not more than five years."
