**"An Act Facilitating Administration Of Various Tax
Laws."**

1 Strike section 37 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 37. Section 12-460a of the general statutes, as amended by
4 section 55 of public act 99-173 and section 13 of public act 99-1 of the
5 June special session, is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
6 thereof:

7 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 13b-61, the
8 Commissioner of Revenue Services shall deposit into the Conservation
9 Fund established under section 22a-27h [two] three million dollars of
10 the amount of the funds received by the state from the tax imposed
11 under this chapter attributable to sales of fuel from distributors to any
12 boat yard, public or private marina or other entity renting or leasing
13 slips, dry storage, mooring or other space for marine vessels provided
14 two hundred fifty thousand dollars shall be credited to the boating

15 account and [one] two million fifty thousand dollars shall be credited
16 to the fisheries account. Amounts in the fisheries account shall be
17 allocated as follows: Not less than seventy-five thousand dollars shall
18 be allocated to The University of Connecticut for the Long Island
19 Sound Councils, not less than seventy-five thousand dollars shall be
20 allocated to the Department of Economic and Community
21 Development for an economic impact study of the lobster industry in
22 Long Island Sound and not less than eight hundred fifty thousand
23 dollars shall be allocated to the Department of Environmental
24 Protection for use as an additional expenditure, in excess of any other
25 state or federal funds made available, for enhancement of recreational
26 fishing in accordance with an allocation which shall be submitted, on
27 or before October 1, 2000, to the joint standing committee of the
28 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the
29 environment."
