## ***An Act Concerning The Activities Of The Department Of Information Technology.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The Chief Information Officer of the Department of  
2 Information Technology shall review the functions and activities of the  
3 department in order to evaluate the cost savings and improvements in  
4 the efficiency and telecommunications systems of state agencies which  
5 are attributable to the efforts of said department. The Chief  
6 Information Officer shall submit findings and recommendations to the  
7 joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance  
8 of matters relating to appropriations and budgets of state agencies not  
9 later than January 10, 2001, and annually thereafter.

**Explanation****State Impact:**

The passage of this bill would not result in a fiscal impact to the state. It requires the Chief Information Officer of the Department of Information Technology (DOIT) to review the functions and activities of the department in order to evaluate the cost savings and improvements in the efficiency of telecommunications systems of state agencies which are attributable to the efforts of DOIT. It also requires the Chief Information Officer to submit findings and recommendations to the Appropriations Committee by January 10, 2001, and annually thereafter. State agencies already report to the Appropriations Committee on an annual basis to review their functions and activities.

**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ACTIVITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY.**

**SUMMARY:**

The bill requires the Chief Information Officer of the Department of Information Technology to review the functions and activities of the department in order to evaluate the cost savings and improvements in the efficiency of telecommunications systems of state agencies which are attributable to the efforts of said department. The Chief Information Officer is required to submit findings and recommendations to the Appropriations Committee not later than January 10, 2001, and annually thereafter.
