An Act Concerning Expenditures For The Programs And Services Of The Connecticut State University.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The Board of Trustees of the Connecticut State University
2 shall review the programs and services administered or provided by
3 the university in order to evaluate the effectiveness and benefits of
4 such programs and services and assign priority for their continued
5 funding. The board shall submit its findings and recommendations to
6 the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
7 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of
8 state agencies not later than January 10, 2001, and annually thereafter.

**AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS
AND SERVICES OF THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY.**

SUMMARY:

This bill requires the Connecticut State University to review and evaluate expenditures for programs and services of the agency. The agency shall submit findings and recommendations not later than January 10, 2001 and annually thereafter to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies.
