An Act Concerning The Name Of The Community-Technical Colleges.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 The Board of Trustees for the Community-Technical Colleges shall
- 2 not change the name of the community-technical colleges. The
- 3 community-technical colleges shall continue to be known as
- 4 community-technical colleges.

Explanation

State Impact:

Passage of the bill prevents the Board of Trustees of the Community-Technical Colleges from changing the name of the community-technical colleges and results in no fiscal impact. It should be noted that the cost associated with removing “technical” from the name of the colleges is estimated at \$40,000 - 50,000. This cost is related to system wide sign changes.
