1 After line 1780, insert the following and renumber the remaining
2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 39. Subsection (c) of section 9-333f of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 (c) The chairman of a political committee formed to support a single
6 candidate for public office shall, not later than seven days after filing a
7 statement of organization with the proper authority under section 9-
8 333e, send the candidate a notice, by certified mail, of such filing. If a
9 candidate (1) does not, within fourteen days after receiving such
10 notice, disavow such committee, in writing, to the proper authority
11 under section 9-333e, or (2) disavows such committee within such
12 period, but, at any time before such disavowal, accepts funds from the
13 committee for [his] the candidate's campaign, such committee shall be
14 deemed to have been authorized by such candidate and shall

15 constitute a candidate committee for the purposes of this chapter. No
16 candidate shall establish, agree to or assist in establishing, or give [his]
17 consent or authorization to establishing a committee other than a
18 single candidate committee to promote [his] the candidate's candidacy
19 for any public office except that a candidate may establish a single
20 political committee, for a single election or primary, for the sole
21 purpose of determining whether to seek (A) nomination or election to
22 the General Assembly, (B) a state office, as defined in subsection (e) of
23 section 9-333l, as amended, or (C) nomination or election to any other
24 public office. The candidate shall designate such purpose on the
25 statement of organization. Not later than six months after a committee
26 is established, the candidate shall declare the intent to seek nomination
27 or election to a particular public office or dissolve the committee. Not
28 later than fifteen days after a public declaration by the candidate of
29 [his] the candidate's intention to seek nomination or election to the
30 General Assembly, a state office, as so defined, or any other particular
31 public office, the candidate shall form a single candidate committee."
