1 After line 51, insert the following and renumber the remaining
2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 3. Notwithstanding any provision of section 14-267a of the
4 general statutes, the Commissioner of Transportation shall not prohibit
5 bulk milk pickup tankers engaged in the transportation of milk or milk
6 products to or from a farm, milk plant, receiving station or transfer
7 station in Connecticut solely on the basis of weight, provided the
8 tanker (1) has a bulk milk pickup tanker permit issued by the
9 Commissioner of Agriculture or issued by a milk-transport regulatory
10 agency of another state that, in the discretion of the Commissioner of
11 Agriculture, has bulk milk pickup tanker permit and safety
12 requirements that are consistent with the requirements of the Grade A
13 Pasteurized Milk Ordinance recommended by the United States
14 Department of Health and Human Services, and (2) has six or more
15 axles and a gross weight of ninety-nine thousand pounds or less."
