1 After line 457, insert the following and renumber the following
2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 3. Subsection (a) of section 17b-749k of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 (a) On and after January 1, 1998, the Commissioner of Social
6 Services shall, within available appropriations, request a fingerprint
7 criminal records check for any person, other than a relative, providing
8 child care services to a child in the child's home who receives a child
9 care subsidy from the Department of Social Services. Such fingerprint
10 criminal records check shall be requested from the State Police Bureau
11 of Identification and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The
12 commissioner shall also request a check of the state child abuse
13 registry established pursuant to section 17a-101k. A fee shall be

14 charged by the commissioner for each such national fingerprint
15 criminal history records check which shall be equal to the fee charged
16 by the Federal Bureau of Investigation for performing such check. The
17 Department of Social Services shall reimburse the Department of
18 Public Safety for the actual cost for a national fingerprint criminal
19 history records check."
