2 accordingly

3 In line 175, strike "or any offense involving"

4 Strike line 176 in its entirety

5 In line 177, strike "another person"

6 After line 229, insert the following:

7 "Sec. 9. Subsection (a) of section 46a-13d of the general statutes is  
8 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

9 (a) All state, local and private agencies shall have a duty to  
10 cooperate with any investigation conducted by the Office of the Victim  
11 Advocate. Consistent with the provisions of the general statutes  
12 concerning the confidentiality of records and information, the Victim  
13 Advocate shall have access to, including the right to inspect and copy,  
14 any records necessary to carry out the responsibilities of the Victim

15 Advocate as provided in section 46a-13c to the same extent as a victim  
16 would have access to such records. Nothing contained in this  
17 subsection shall be construed to waive a victim's right to  
18 confidentiality of communication or records as protected by and  
19 provisions of the general statutes or common law."
