"An Act Concerning Reforming The Sheriff System."

1 After line 3554, add the following and renumber the remaining
2 sections and internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 131. (NEW) No state marshal shall knowingly bill for, or
4 receive fees for, work that such state marshal did not actually perform.

5 Sec. 132. (NEW) (a) No person who is an appointing authority for
6 the State Marshal Commission under section 8 of this act may directly
7 or indirectly coerce, attempt to coerce, command or advise a state
8 marshal to pay, lend or contribute anything of value to a party,
9 committee, organization, agency or person for political purposes.

10 (b) Any person contributing to the political campaign of a person
11 who is an appointing authority for the State Marshal Commission shall
12 not be eligible for appointment as a state marshal for a period of two
13 years after such contribution.

14 Sec. 133. (NEW) The State Marshal Commission shall periodically
15 review and audit the records and accounts of the state marshals. Upon

16 the death or disability of a state marshal, the commission shall appoint
17 a qualified individual to oversee and audit the records and accounts of
18 such state marshal and render an accounting to the commission."
