1 After line 3554, add the following and renumber the remaining
2 sections and internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 131. (NEW) (a) The Department of Correction may provide
4 personnel to assist the state marshals in the exercise of their prisoner
5 custody and transportation responsibilities whenever state marshals
6 have custody of or are transporting prisoners who are especially
7 dangerous and pose a risk of physical violence or escape.

8 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, the
9 Department of Correction, in order to relieve prison overcrowding,
10 may transport arrested persons awaiting a court appearance to
11 courthouse lockups, and such persons may be held in such lockups for
12 not more than seventy-two hours."
