"An Act Providing A Property Tax Abatement For Certain Personal Property, Technical Corrections Regarding The Veterans Exemption And Revisions To Requirements Of Boards Of Assessment Appeals And Establishing A Property Tax Credit Relief Program For Firefighters And Emergency Medical Personnel."

1 Strike out section 10 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 10. Section 6 of public act 99-272 is amended to read as follows:

4 The legislative body of any municipality may establish, by
5 ordinance, a program to [abate up to one thousand dollars in property
6 taxes due for any fiscal year for a resident of the municipality] provide
7 property tax relief for individuals who [volunteers his or her]
8 volunteer their services as a firefighter, emergency medical technician,
9 paramedic or ambulance driver in the municipality. Such tax relief
10 may provide either (a) an abatement of up to one thousand dollars in
11 property taxes due for any fiscal year, or (b) an exemption applicable
12 to the assessed value of real or personal property in an amount equal

13 to the quotient of one million dollars divided by the mill rate, in effect
14 at the time of assessment, expressed as a whole number of dollars per
15 one thousand dollars of assessed value. Any ordinance may authorize
16 interlocal agreements for the purpose of providing property tax relief
17 to such volunteers who live in one municipality but volunteer their
18 services in another municipality."

19 In line 440 strike out "and" and strike out "10" and insert "9" in lieu

21 In line 441 before the period insert the following "and section 10
22 shall be applicable to assessment years commencing October 1, 1999"
