1 Strike lines 567 to 594, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Sec. 12. (NEW) (a) The expenditure limit under the Citizens'
4 Election Program in 2006, and thereafter, for a primary campaign for
5 each qualifying candidate for nomination to the office of Governor
6 who receives fifteen per cent or more of the votes of the convention
7 delegates of the candidate's party who are present and voting on any
8 roll-call taken on the endorsement or proposed endorsement of a
9 candidate for said office shall be one million five hundred thousand
10 dollars, subject to adjustment under subsection (e) of this section."

11 Strike lines 601 to 627, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the
12 following in lieu thereof:

13 "(c) The expenditure limit under the Citizens' Election Program in
14 2006, and thereafter, for a primary campaign for each qualifying

15 candidate for nomination to the office of Lieutenant Governor,
16 Attorney General, State Comptroller, Secretary of the State or State
17 Treasurer who receives fifteen per cent or more of the votes of the
18 convention delegates of the candidate's party who are present and
19 voting on any roll-call taken on the endorsement or proposed
20 endorsement of a candidate for said office shall be five hundred
21 thousand dollars, subject to adjustment under subsection (e) of this
22 section."
