***"An Act Concerning The Composition Of Medical
Hearing Panels."***

1 After the last line, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 3. Subsection (c) of section 20-12d of the general statutes, as
3 amended by section 9 of public act 99-102, is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 (c) No physician assistant may: (1) Engage in the independent
6 practice of medicine; (2) claim to be or allow being represented as a
7 physician licensed pursuant to this chapter; (3) use the title of doctor;
8 or (4) associate by name or allow association by name with any term
9 that would suggest qualification to engage in the independent practice
10 of medicine. The physician assistant shall, [be clearly identified by
11 appropriate identification as a] at all times while performing delegated
12 medical functions with patients, wear a name tag that clearly displays
13 the designation of physician assistant to ensure that the physician
14 assistant is not mistaken for a physician licensed pursuant to this
15 chapter."
