**"An Act Concerning Payment In Lieu Of Tax Revenue  
For Electric Generation Facilities And Certain Property  
Assessment And Tax Exemption Related Forms."**

1 After section 9, add the following and renumber the remaining

2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 10. (NEW) The legislative body of any municipality may  
4 establish, by ordinance, a program to abate all or a portion of the  
5 property taxes due with respect to real property owned and occupied  
6 as the principal residence of the surviving spouse of a police officer or  
7 firefighter who dies while in the performance of such officer's or  
8 firefighter's duties. Such ordinance shall provide that the surviving  
9 spouse shall be eligible for the abatement until remarriage or death."
