2 After line 53, insert the following:
3 "Sec. 2. (NEW) (a) No owner of a video game arcade or any video
4 games in such other facilities, including, but not limited to, fairs, movie
5 theaters, shopping malls, hotels, schools and carnivals, shall permit a
6 person under the age of eighteen to operate a point and shoot video
7 simulator. A point and shoot video simulator is a device that involves
8 one or two individuals firing simulated hand guns at a video screen
9 which depicts human silhouettes, life-like representations of human
10 beings and civilian transportation services, including, but not limited
11 to, representations of cars, buses, trains, aircraft and commercial and
12 residential structures.
13 (b) Violation of this section shall be an infraction."
