1 After line 288, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 14. Subsection (h) of section 21a-70 of the general statutes is
3 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

4 (h) No manufacturer or wholesaler shall sell any drugs except to the
5 state or any political subdivision thereof, to another manufacturer or
6 wholesaler, to any hospital recognized by the state as a general or
7 specialty hospital, to any institution having a full-time pharmacist who
8 is actively engaged in the practice of pharmacy in such institution not
9 less than thirty-five hours a week, to a chronic and convalescent
10 nursing home having a pharmacist actively engaged in the practice of
11 pharmacy based upon the ratio of one-tenth of one hour per patient
12 per week but not less than ten hours per week, to a practicing

13 physician, podiatrist, dentist, optometrist or veterinarian or to a
14 licensed pharmacy or a store to which a permit to sell nonlegend drugs
15 has been issued as provided in section 20-624, as amended by section
16 43 of public act 99-175. The commissioner may adopt such regulations
17 as are necessary to administer and enforce the provisions of this
18 section."
