***"An Act Making Changes To Retirement Benefits Under
The Teachers' Retirement System."***

1 After line 18 insert the following and renumber the remaining
2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 3. Subdivision (3) of section 10-183b of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 (3) "Annual salary" means the annual salary rate for service as a
6 Connecticut teacher during a school year but not including unused
7 sick leave, unused vacation, terminal pay, coaching or extra duty
8 assignments, unless compensation for coaching or extra duty
9 assignment was included in salary for which contributions were made
10 prior to July 1, 1971. In no event shall annual salary include amounts
11 determined by the board to be included for the purpose of inflating the
12 member's average annual salary. The inclusion in annual salary of
13 amounts paid to the member, in lieu of payment by the employer for
14 the cost of benefits, insurance, or individual retirement arrangements
15 which in prior years had been paid by the employer and not included

16 in the member's annual salary, shall be prima facie evidence that such
17 amounts are included for the purpose of inflating the member's
18 average annual salary. Annual salary shall not include payments the
19 timing of which may be directed by the member. Annual salary shall
20 not include payments to a superintendent pursuant to an individual
21 contract between such superintendent and a board of education, of
22 amounts which are not included in base salary. Annual salary shall
23 include amounts paid to the member during a sabbatical leave during
24 which mandatory contributions were remitted, provided such member
25 returned to full-time teaching for at least five full years following the
26 completion of such leave."
