***"An Act Concerning Safety Inspections For Fire
Department Apparatus."***

1 In line 1, before "(NEW)" insert "Section 1."

2 After line 5, add the following:

3 "Sec. 2. Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, for
4 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, one hundred thousand dollars
5 shall be disbursed from the Tobacco Settlement Fund to an account to
6 be established in the Office of Policy and Management. Such funds
7 shall not lapse on June 30, 2000, and shall continue to be available for
8 expenditure during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001. The Secretary
9 of the Office of Policy and Management may use the funds in the
10 account established under this section to make grants to youth
11 organizations that are tax-exempt organizations under Section
12 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or any subsequent
13 corresponding internal revenue code of the United States, as from time
14 to time amended, to pay for criminal background checks for volunteers
15 of such organizations.

16 Sec. 6. This act shall take effect from its passage, except that section
17 1 shall take effect October 1, 2000."
