1 After line 57, insert the following and renumber the remaining
2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 4. Section 1-86e of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 (a) No person hired by the state as a consultant or independent
6 contractor shall:

7 (1) Use the authority provided to the person under the contract, or
8 any confidential information acquired in the performance of the
9 contract, to obtain financial gain for the person, an employee of the
10 person or a member of the immediate family of any such person or
11 employee;

12 (2) Accept another state contract which would impair the
13 independent judgment of the person in the performance of the existing

14 contract; or

15 (3) Accept anything of value based on an understanding that the
16 actions of the person on behalf of the state would be influenced.

17 (b) No person shall give anything of value to a person hired by the
18 state as a consultant or independent contractor based on an
19 understanding that the actions of the consultant or independent
20 contractor on behalf of the state would be influenced.

21 (c) For purposes of this section, a person who contracts with the
22 state as a vendor or provider of goods or services, including, but not
23 limited to, human services, as defined in subsection (a) of section 4b-
24 31, shall not be deemed to be a consultant or independent contractor
25 by virtue of such contract."

26 In line 58, after "effect" insert "from its passage, except that sections
27 1 to 3, inclusive, shall take effect"
