"An Act Concerning Civil Actions Against Crime Victims."

1 Strike out everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(NEW) (a) No owner of a video game arcade or any video games in
4 such other facilities, including, but not limited to, fairs, movie theaters,
5 shopping malls, hotels, schools and carnivals, shall permit a person
6 under the age of eighteen to operate a point and shoot video simulator.
7 A point and shoot video simulator is a device that involves one or two
8 individuals firing simulated hand guns at a video screen which depicts
9 human silhouettes, life-like representations of human beings and
10 civilian transportation services, including, but not limited to,
11 representations of cars, buses, trains, aircraft and commercial and
12 residential structures.

13 (b) Violation of this section shall be an infraction."
