**"An Act Concerning Investigative Subpoenas."**

1 In line 17, after "investigation" insert "and prior to the arrest of any  
2 person as a result of such investigation"

3 In line 19, after the period insert "No prosecuting official may issue  
4 a subpoena under this section to an attorney who represents or  
5 represented a person who is a target or possible target of the  
6 investigation, which representation is or was in connection with the  
7 subject matter of the investigation."

8 In line 40, after the semi-colon strike "and"

9 In line 43, strike the period and insert a semi-colon in lieu thereof

10 After line 43, add the following:

11 "(5) Has tried other normal investigative procedures with respect to  
12 the subject matter of the investigation and such procedures have failed  
13 or reasonably appear to be unlikely to succeed if tried or to be too  
14 dangerous to employ."
