1 In line 10, strike out "and"

2 In line 11, after "act" and before the period insert the following: ";
3 and all or any part of the Drug and Alcohol Resistance Education
4 (DARE) Fund created in section 4 of this act"

5 In line 28, strike out "and"

6 In line 29, after "dollars" and before the period insert the following:
7 "; and (D) to the Drug and Alcohol Resistance Education (DARE) Fund
8 in an amount equal to seventy-five thousand dollars"

9 After line 64, insert the following:

10 "Sec. 4. (NEW) There is created a Drug and Alcohol Resistance
11 Education (DARE) Fund which shall be a separate nonlapsing fund.
12 The fund may accept transfers from the Tobacco Settlement Fund and
13 may apply for and accept gifts, grants or donations from public or
14 private sources to enable the fund to carry out its objectives. The fund

15 shall be used by the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management
16 to make matching grants to municipalities for the purpose of funding
17 local Drug and Alcohol Resistance Education (DARE) programs. The
18 secretary may adopt regulations, in accordance with chapter 54 of the
19 general statutes, to carry out the provisions of this section."
