2 After line 6 insert the following:

3 "Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 5-249 of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 (a) Any state employee who is an active volunteer firefighter or  
6 member of a volunteer ambulance service or company may, with the  
7 authorization of his appointing authority, be permitted to respond to  
8 fire calls or ambulance calls during his regular hours of employment  
9 [without loss of] and, if so permitted, shall not lose pay, vacation time,  
10 sick leave or earned overtime accumulation."
