***"An Act Concerning The Use Of Tobacco Settlement
Funds For Biomedical Research."***

1 After section 3, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 4. (NEW) The Department of Public Health and the
3 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services shall develop,
4 within existing appropriations, a comprehensive plan, for the
5 reduction of smoking by adolescents. The comprehensive plan shall
6 provide strategies to significantly reduce smoking by adolescents less
7 than seventeen years of age from the prevailing rate in the 1996-1997
8 school year for students and young adults by October 1, 2010.
9 Biennially, after the date of adoption of the plan, the department shall
10 assess the progress in implementing the plan using the best available
11 data."
