***"An Act Concerning The Use Of Tobacco Settlement
Funds For Biomedical Research."***

1 After line 64, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 4. Subsection (e) of section 26 of public act 99-2 of the June
3 special session is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
4 thereof:

5 (e) Grants shall be made by the Secretary of the Office of Policy and
6 Management in consultation with the speaker of the House of
7 Representatives, the president pro tempore of the Senate, the majority
8 leader of the House of Representatives, the majority leader of the
9 Senate, the minority leader of the House of Representatives, the
10 minority leader of the Senate, and the cochairpersons and ranking
11 members of the joint standing committees of the General Assembly
12 having cognizance of matters relating to public health and
13 appropriations and the budgets of state agencies, or their designees.
14 Such grants shall be used to (1) reduce tobacco abuse through

15 prevention, education, cessation, treatment, enforcement and health
16 needs programs, and (2) provide funding for expanded coverage
17 under the ConnPACE program pursuant to section 17b-492.

18 Sec. 5. Section 27 of public act 99-2 of the June special session is
19 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

20 There is created a Tobacco and Health Trust Fund which shall be a
21 separate nonlapsing fund. The trust fund may accept transfers from
22 the Tobacco Settlement Fund and may apply for and accept gifts,
23 grants or donations from public or private sources to enable the trust
24 fund to carry out its objectives."
