**"An Act Concerning The Mandatory School Attendance Age."**

1 After line 164, insert the following and renumber the remaining  
2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 8. Subsection (h) of section 10-266aa of the general statutes, as  
4 amended by section 1 of public act 99-289, is repealed and the  
5 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

6 (h) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter, each sending  
7 district and each receiving district shall divide the number of children  
8 participating in the program who reside in such district or attend  
9 school in such district by two for purposes of the counts for  
10 subdivision (22) of section 10-262f and subdivision (2) of subsection (a)  
11 of section 10-261. The Department of Education shall (1) increase the  
12 grant under section 10-262h, as amended, of each receiving district by  
13 one thousand dollars for each out-of-district student who attends  
14 school in such receiving district under the program, and (2) reduce  
15 such grant to the sending district by one thousand dollars for each  
16 student residing in the sending district who attends school in another

17 district under the program."
