1 After line 54, add the following:

2 "Sec. 3. Subsection (a) of section 46a-13d of the general statutes is
3 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

4 (a) All state, local and private agencies shall have a duty to
5 cooperate with any investigation conducted by the Office of the Victim
6 Advocate. Consistent with the provisions of the general statutes
7 concerning the confidentiality of records and information, the Victim
8 Advocate shall have access to, including the right to inspect and copy,
9 any records necessary to carry out the responsibilities of the Victim
10 Advocate as provided in section 46a-13c. [to the same extent as a
11 victim would have access to such records.] Nothing contained in this
12 subsection shall be construed to waive a victim's right to
13 confidentiality of communication or records as protected by and
14 provisions of the general statutes or common law."
