Environmental Laws."***

1 After line 269, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 12. Section 22a-133aa of the general statutes is amended by  
3 adding subsection (f) as follows:

4 (NEW) (f) The commissioner may enter into a covenant not to sue  
5 pursuant to this section that releases owners or prospective purchasers  
6 from causes of action or claims for contribution by any person other  
7 than the federal government, provided (1) the property has been  
8 remediated to the standards adopted pursuant to section 22a-133k, and  
9 (2) the commissioner formally reviewed and approved in writing the  
10 investigation and remediation of the parcel including any  
11 modifications, has determined that no further remedial action or  
12 continued monitoring is necessary, and has approved in writing a final  
13 remedial action report. Protection against third party liability provided  
14 in this subsection shall not be transferable to successors in interest."
