An Act Concerning The River View Cemetery, Incorporated.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 368j and section 33-264g
2 of the general statutes concerning the purposes for which a cemetery
3 association may be organized and the purposes for which a cemetery
4 fund and the income therefrom may be used, the board of directors of
5 the River View Cemetery, Incorporated, are authorized to transfer
6 from time to time principal and income from the cemetery fund in
7 excess of that amount determined by the board to be necessary in the
8 present and future to operate and maintain Grove Cemetery and River
9 View Cemetery in accordance with the provisions of said chapter and
10 section, to one or more organizations described in Section 509(a)(1),
11 509(a)(2) or 509(a)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or any
12 subsequent corresponding internal revenue code of the United States,
13 as from time to time amended, selected by the board of directors
14 provided such selection is approved by the members of said
15 corporation at their annual meeting or at a special meeting called for
16 that purpose.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize the River View Cemetery, Incorporated to transfer excess cemetery funds to charitable organizations.
