***An Act Concerning A Competitive Grant Program For Certain High School Projects.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) The Department of Education shall establish a  
2 competitive grant program for high school projects that involve one or  
3 more of the following topics: Computers, engineering, mathematics,  
4 physics, science or technical construction. Local and regional boards of  
5 education may apply, on behalf of a high school under their  
6 jurisdiction, for a grant pursuant to this section at such time and in  
7 such manner as the Commissioner of Education prescribes.

8 Sec. 2. The sum of fifty thousand dollars is appropriated to the  
9 Department of Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, for  
10 the grant program established pursuant to section 1 of this act.

11 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To establish a competitive grant program for high school projects involving computers, engineering, mathematics, physics, science or technical construction.
