***An Act Concerning Universal Enforcement Authority For Labor Law Violations.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 (NEW) Any investigator employed by a division or unit within the
- 2 Labor Department, the Department of Consumer Protection or the
- 3 office of the Chief State's Attorney who, while investigating a claim
- 4 that falls within the investigator's jurisdiction, becomes aware of a
- 5 potential violation of any provision of Title 31 of the general statutes
- 6 shall make complaint to the proper prosecuting authority.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To require state investigators to identify and report suspected labor law violations to the appropriate prosecuting authorities.
