An Act Concerning Transportation For Shelter Residents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (a) The Commissioner of Transportation shall establish a
2 demonstration program to improve transportation services for shelter
3 residents seeking employment, medical services and permanent
4 housing. Grants shall be made under the program to municipalities,
5 regional transportation districts and nonprofit organizations for the
6 purpose of developing and operating innovative transportation
7 projects that improve transportation services for such shelter residents.
8 No grant made in any fiscal year shall be less than ten thousand
9 dollars or exceed fifty thousand dollars.

10 (b) The Commissioner of Transportation shall collect data in order
11 to analyze the strengths and shortcomings of the demonstration
12 program and to evaluate the effectiveness and impact of the various
13 innovative transportation projects.

14 Sec. 2. The sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars is
15 appropriated to the Department of Transportation from the Special
16 Transportation Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, for the

17 purposes of the demonstration program established under section 1 of
18 this act.

19 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.
