***Resolution Concerning The Rules Of The House For The June,  
2000 Special Session.***

Resolved by this House:

1 That the rules of the House at this Special Session shall be the same as  
2 the rules of the House in force at the 2000 regular session, except as said  
3 rules are herein amended, altered or repealed.

4 Strike out Rule 9.

5 Strike out Rule 11 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

6 11. Each bill may be acted upon in the house when it is placed on the  
7 desks of the members and may be transmitted immediately to the  
8 Senate. If the House rejects an amendment adopted by the Senate, the bill  
9 after final action in the house, may be transmitted immediately to the  
10 Senate, or if the Senate rejects an amendment adopted by the House, the  
11 bill when received from the Senate may be acted upon immediately.

12 Strike out Rules 15, 19 and 20.

13 Strike out Rule 21 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

14 21. The order of business shall be as follows:

15 1. Reception of communications from the Governor.

16 2. Introduction of bills and resolutions.

17 3. Reception of business from the Senate.

18 4. Miscellaneous.

19 Add a new Rule 48 as follows:

20 48. Only those bills specified in Rule 7 of the Joint Rules for this  
21 session certified as provided in Rule 9 of said Rules, and, except as  
22 provided in joint rule 33, only those resolutions pertaining to the rules of  
23 this Special Session and the printing of the journals of the senate and the  
24 house of representatives and the expenses of this Special Session, shall be  
25 received.
