



**An Act Concerning Authorization Of State Grant Commitments
For School Building Projects.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. The Commissioner of Education having reviewed
2 applications for state grants for public school building projects in
3 accordance with section 10-283 of the general statutes on the basis of
4 priorities for such projects and standards for school construction
5 established by the State Board of Education, and having prepared a
6 listing of all such eligible projects ranked in order of priority, including
7 a separate schedule of previously authorized projects which have
8 changed substantially in scope or cost, as determined by said
9 commissioner together with the amount of estimated grant with
10 respect to each eligible project, and having submitted such listing of
11 eligible projects, prior to December 15, 1999, to a committee of the
12 General Assembly established under section 10-283a of the general
13 statutes for the purpose of reviewing such listing, is hereby authorized
14 to enter into grant commitments on behalf of the state in accordance
15 with said section 10-283 with respect to the priority listing of such
16 projects and in such estimated amounts as approved by said
17 committee prior to February 1, 2000, as follows:
