An Act Concerning Sheet Metal Workers And New Home Construction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (5) of section 20-330 of the general statutes, as
2 amended by section 1 of public act 99-253, is repealed and the
3 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

4 (5) "Heating, piping and cooling work" means (A) the installation,
5 repair, replacement, maintenance or alteration of any apparatus for
6 piping, appliances, devices or accessories for heating systems,
7 [excluding] including sheet metal work, [;] and (B) the installation,
8 repair, replacement, maintenance or alteration of air conditioning and
9 refrigeration systems, boilers, including apparatus and piping for the
10 generation or conveyance of steam and associated pumping
11 equipment. [, but] Heating, piping and cooling work does not include
12 solar work.

13 Sec. 2. (NEW) Sections 1 to 9, inclusive, of public act 99-246 do not
14 apply to any person holding a professional or occupational license,
15 registration or certificate issued pursuant to the general statutes,

16 provided such person engages only in that work for which such
17 person is licensed.

18 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect from its passage.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the definition of "heating, piping and cooling work" to include sheet metal work; and to exempt from public act 99-246 professions and occupations that are already licensed, registered, or certified under the general statutes.
