***An Act Concerning Development Plans For State Universities.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1       (NEW) The University of Connecticut may, as part of any facility or  
2 area development plan, satisfy the requirement under section 22a-1b of  
3 the general statutes of a written evaluation of the environmental  
4 impacts of each proposed action by (1) making separate written  
5 evaluations of the environmental impacts of each specific project  
6 proposed in such plan for which a written evaluation of the  
7 environmental impacts would be required, or, (2) by making a  
8 comprehensive written evaluation of the environmental impacts of the  
9 projects proposed in the plan as a whole. If The University of  
10 Connecticut chooses to make a comprehensive written evaluation,  
11 such evaluation shall include all the information required under  
12 subsection (b) of section 22a-1b of the general statutes. The provisions  
13 of sections 22a-1d and 22a-1e of the general statutes shall apply to a  
14 comprehensive written evaluation made pursuant to this section.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To authorize The University of Connecticut to make a comprehensive environmental impact statement for more than one proposed action in certain limited circumstances.
