An Act Concerning The Expenditures Of The Department Of Consumer Protection.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The Commissioner of Consumer Protection shall review the
2 programs and services administered or provided by the Department of
3 Consumer Protection in order to determine the cost-effectiveness of
4 such programs and services. The commissioner shall submit findings,
5 including any recommendations for legislation to modify programs or
6 services in order to increase cost-effectiveness, to the joint standing
7 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
8 relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not later
9 than January 10, 2001, and annually thereafter.
