The Committee on Judiciary reported through REP. LAWLOR of the 99th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS FROM DOCUMENTS TO BE RECORDED ON THE LAND RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 (NEW) Any person whose Social Security number appears on a
- 2 document that is to be recorded on the land records of a municipality
- 3 may expunge or cause to be expunged such Social Security number
- 4 prior to the recording of such document.

Explanation

Municipal Impact:

Permitting individuals whose social security number appears on a land record filed with a municipality, to expunge the social security number before it is recorded will result in a workload increase to the municipalities. It is anticipated that municipalities can handle this within their normal budgetary resources, thus there is no fiscal impact.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS FROM DOCUMENTS TO BE RECORDED ON THE LAND RECORDS.

This bill allows anyone whose Social Security number appears on a document that is to be recorded on a municipality's land records to remove it before the document is recorded.
