AN ACT CONCERNING PEDIATRIC NURSES IN INVESTIGATIONS OF INFANTS AT RISK OF ABUSE OR NEGLECT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 On or before January 1, 2002, the Department of Children and
- 2 Families shall report to the select committee of the General Assembly
- 3 having cognizance of matters relating to children the extent to which
- 4 pediatric nurses are included in investigations of infants at risk of
- 5 abuse or neglect prior to the infant's discharge from a hospital.
