***AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OF THE AGENCIES WITHIN THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The Joint Committee on Legislative Management shall  
2 review the operation, administration and management of the  
3 programs and services administered or provided by the agencies  
4 within the legislative department in order to evaluate the  
5 cost-effectiveness of such programs and services. The committee shall  
6 submit recommendation to increase cost-effectiveness to the joint  
7 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of  
8 matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not  
9 later than February 20, 2002, and annually thereafter.

HB 7030

**AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OF THE AGENCIES WITHIN THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT.**

**SUMMARY:**

The bill requires the Joint Committee on Legislative Management to review the operation, administration and management of the programs and services provided by the agencies within the legislative department. The committee shall submit recommendations to increase cost-effectiveness not later than February 20, 2002 (and annually thereafter), to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the budget of state agencies.
