AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The Board of Governors of Higher Education shall review
2 the programs and services administered or provided by the
3 Department of Higher Education in order to assess the effectiveness
4 and the benefits of such programs and services and assign priority for
5 their continued funding. The board shall submit its findings and
6 recommendations to the joint standing committee of the General
7 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and
8 the budgets of state agencies not later than February 20, 2002, and
9 annually thereafter.
