AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OF THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The Board of Trustees of the Connecticut State University
2 shall review the programs and services administered or provided by
3 the university in order to evaluate the effectiveness and benefits of
4 such programs and services and assign priority for their continued
5 funding. The board shall submit its findings and recommendations to
6 the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
7 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of
8 state agencies not later than February 20, 2002, and annually thereafter.
