AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OF THE REGIONAL COMMUNITY-TECHNICAL COLLEGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 (NEW) The Board of Trustees of the Community-Technical Colleges
- 2 shall review the programs and services administered or provided by
- 3 the Regional Community-Technical Colleges in order to assess the
- 4 effectiveness and benefits of such programs and services and assign
- 5 priority for their continued funding. The board shall submit its
- 6 findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of the
- 7 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
- 8 appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not later than
- 9 February 20, 2002, and annually thereafter.
