AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPENDITURES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The Commissioner of Correction shall review the programs
2 administered by the department in order to: (1) Evaluate the
3 cost-effectiveness and benefits of such programs, and (2) assign
4 priority for the continued funding of such programs. The
5 commissioner shall submit findings and recommendations to the joint
6 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
7 matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not
8 later than February 20, 2002, and annually thereafter.
