Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the recommendation of the Claims Commissioner, file number
- 2 10176 of said commissioner, that an award of one hundred fifty
- 3 thousand dollars be granted to Stephen M. Granoth on his claim
- 4 against the state in excess of seven thousand five hundred dollars, is
- 5 altered by directing the Comptroller to pay in lieu of said amount an
- 6 award of one hundred eighty thousand dollars to the claimant.
