AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT HEALTH CENTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 (NEW) The Board of Trustees of The University of Connecticut shall
- 2 review the programs and services administered or provided by the
- 3 health center in order to assess the effectiveness and benefits of such
- 4 programs and services and assign priority for their continued funding.
- 5 The board shall report its findings and recommendations to the joint
- 6 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 7 matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not
- 8 later than February 20, 2002, and annually thereafter.
